

## **Trillium Photographic Club Louise Elder Trophy for Best Canadian Wildflower**

### **Competition Entry Rules 2017 – 2018 Season**

1. Maximum of 4 entries per member. Deadline is March 6, 2018
2. All entries must be identified with the maker's Clinic Number and Title.
3. They are to be sized the same as for Clinics.
4. The File Name Format is: Maker's Clinic Number-Title.  
for example: 99-Jack in the Pulpit (not there are no hypens in the title).
5. Images entered into any past Trillium Wildflower Competitions are not eligible.
6. Image entries must fit the definition as printed in the Handbook and shown below.

\*\*\*Please note they must be Canadian\*\*\*

Louise Elder Trophy for Best Wildflower is awarded to the member with the top image entered into this annual competition. This Award is for the flower of any identifiable wild Canadian plant including grasses, sedges, shrubs and trees. The image must include, as the centre of interest, any stage of the flower, either in bud, blooming or in seed.

A Field Guide of Canadian Wildflower or Trees and Shrubs will be used as a reference to verify eligibility. Image must be titled with the botanical or common name. No manipulation of the image beyond the outlined in the rules for Nature images is permitted.

The Club reserves the right to not award the Trophy if minimum standards are not shown.
