We welcome new members, new ideas, and new challenges. Join us to learn, improve and enjoy photography.

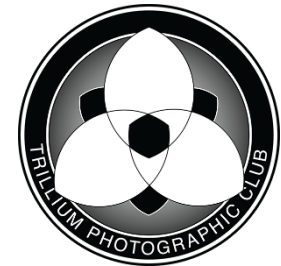
