

## Creating a Triptych in IrfanView — Quick Guide

### 1. Open your first image

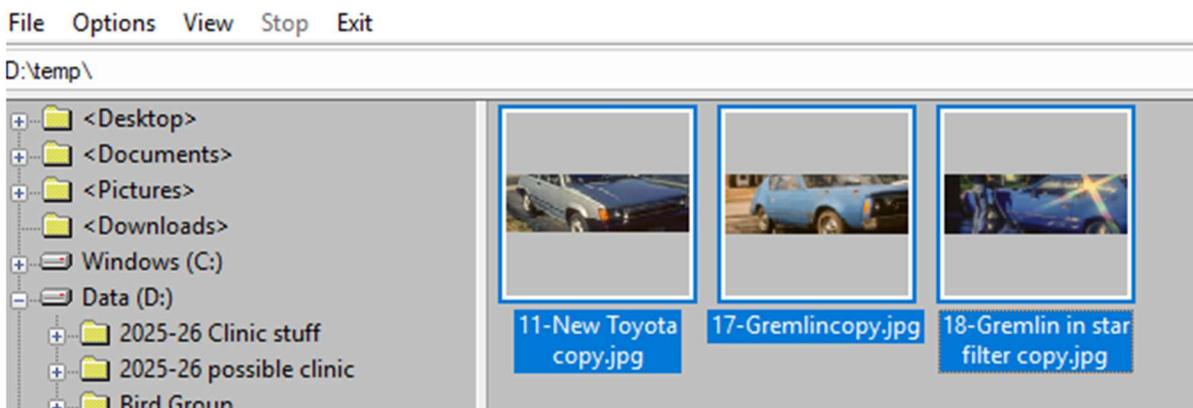
- Launch IrfanView and open any one of the images you plan to use.

### 2. Open the Thumbnail Browser

- Press **T** to bring up the thumbnail window.
- Navigate to the folder containing your three images.
- You might find it easier to put the 3 in a separate folder.

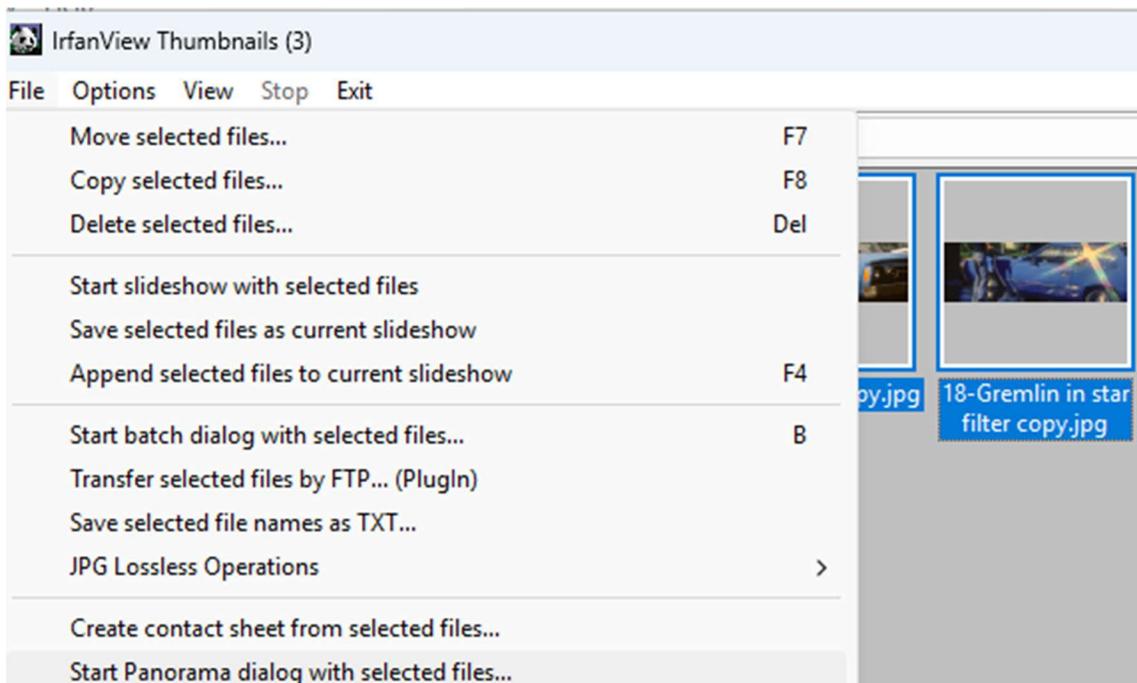
### 3. Select your three images

- Select the **three photos** you want in your triptych.



### 4. Start the Panorama Tool

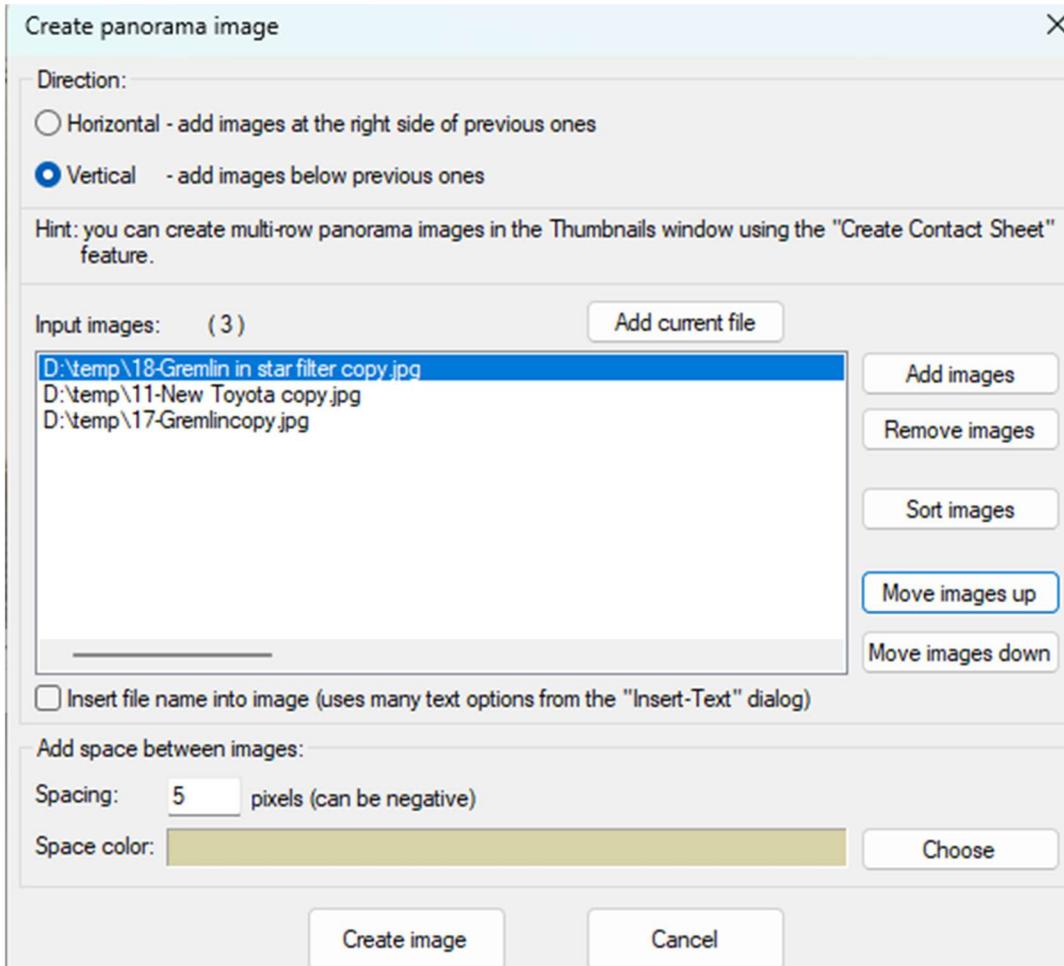
- Go to **File → Start Panorama Dialog with Selected Files.**



- Ideally, you will have cropped and sized your images to suit a horizontal or vertical format.
- The 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> images will be resized to match the first if they are not all the same size.

## 5. Choose your layout

- Select **Horizontal** if your images are tall/portrait-oriented.
- Select **Vertical** if your images are wide/panorama-style.



## 6. Arrange and customize

- You can add or remove images.
- Use the Move images up or Move images down or Sort images buttons to change their order.
- Set the **spacing** between images.
- Choose a **space color**.
  - While you can pick a **Custom Color**, it's probably easier to use a preset colour to match the frame if you want one.

## 7. Create the triptych

- Click **Create Image** to generate the combined file.

## 8. Resize for competition

- Press **Ctrl-R** and resize the width to **1400 pixels** or height to **1050 pixels**.

## 8. Add a frame (optional)

- Go to **Image** → **Add border/frame**.
- Choose a frame style and colour you like.

## 10. Final resize

- Adding a frame increases the width, so resize again to **1400** or **1050 pixels**.

## 11. Save your image
